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#### Medical misinformation policy









## Bradford Hill criteria (1965)

**Strength**, the larger the association, the more likely that it is causal.

Consistency, (Reproducibility) Consistent findings observed by different persons in different places

**Specificity**, Lack of other likely explanation.

**Temporality**, The effect has to occur after the cause

## Bradford Hill criteria (1965)

Biological gradient, Dose response or mere presence of the factor Positive or protective Plausibility, Mechanism between cause and effect Coherence, Between epidemiological and laboratory findings

Experiment, Occasionally possible

Analogy, Similarities between the observed association and other associations.
